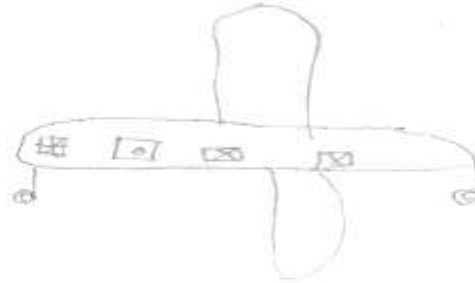
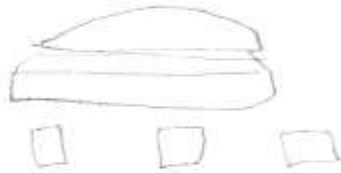
Holiday news : \_\_\_\_\_ Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> June
