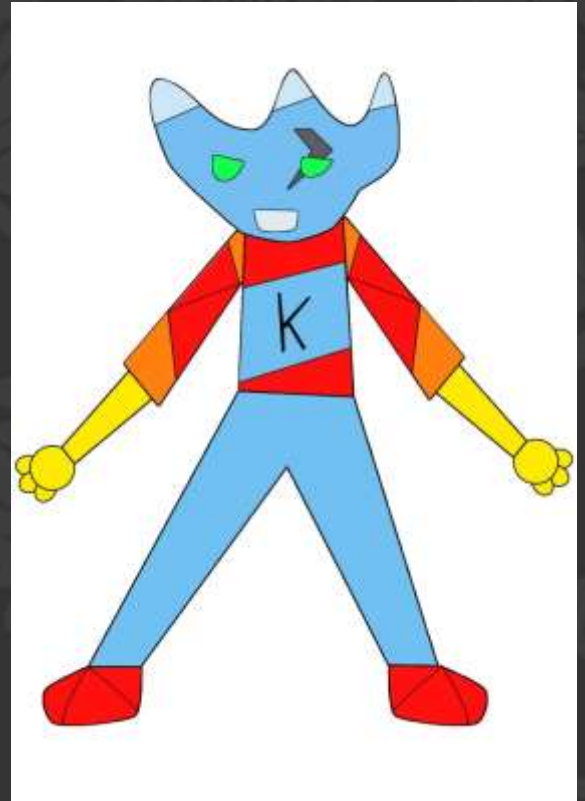

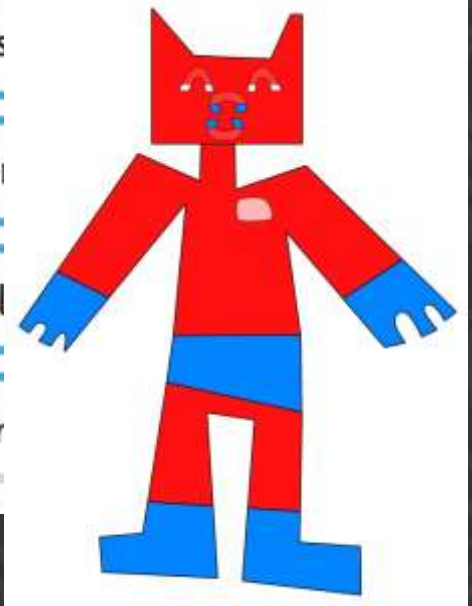

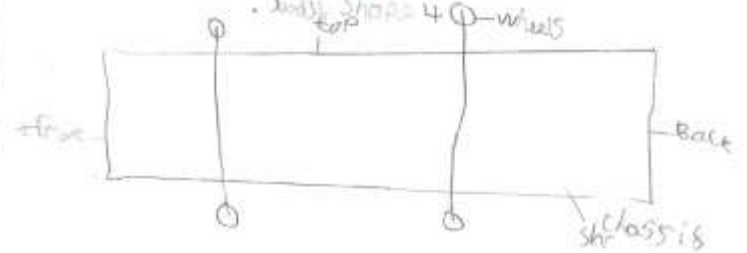

At night, she was dancing gracefully at

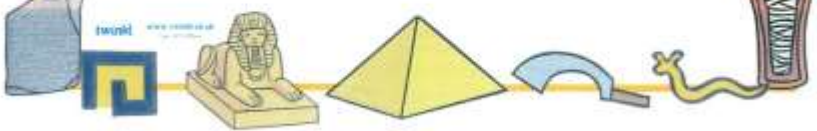

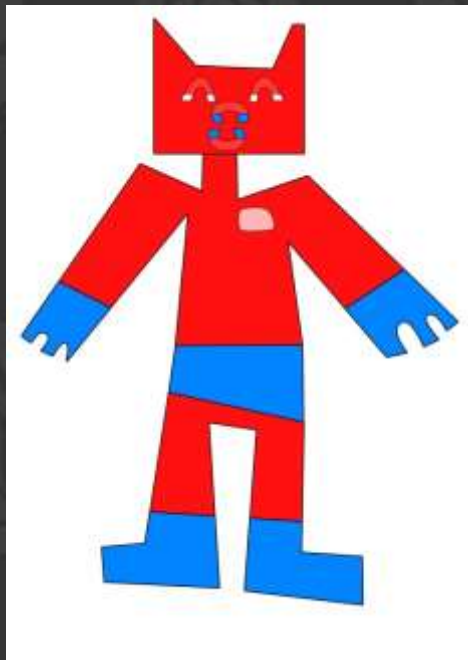

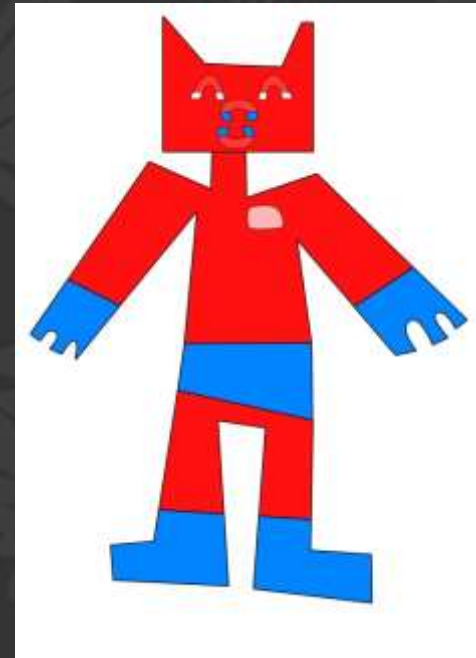
