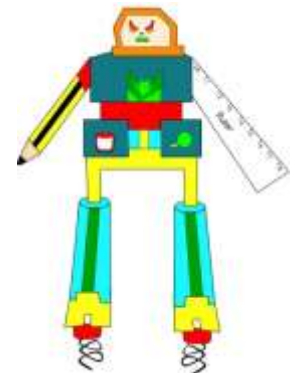
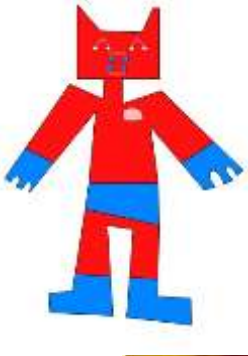

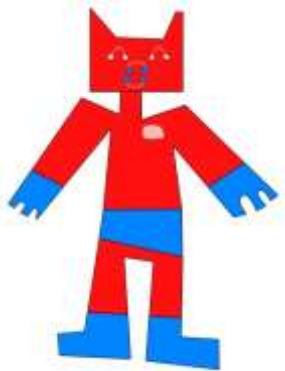
the best family that anyone could ever have asked for

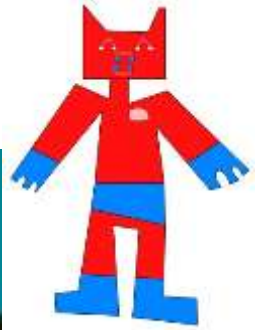
