What do we offer?

Children who have a place at the Resourced Provision for Language Impairment have a Statement of Special Educational Needs detailing severe language impairment. These may include receptive and expressive disorders, pragmatic and semantic difficulties and significant language delay.

Your child will receive:-

Regular access to speech and language therapy, either through individual or group therapy.

An educational program tailored to meet their specific needs.

Additional support to gain confidence and learning strategies to lead to independent learning.

Support and encouragement to achieve their potential.

Opportunities to integrate into the mainstream classroom to access the National Curriculum, with modification as appropriate.

Working Together

We very much want to work in a collaborative partnership with parents and other professionals.

During the year you will be invited to :

- Parent's evenings to meet your child's teacher in the Provision and the Mainstream class.
- Meet the Speech and Language Therapists and other professional after a period of assessment.
- Coffee afternoons for parents.

Assessment is an ongoing process and all professionals working with your child are invited to meet with you to discuss your child's progress and placement within the Resourced Provision for Language Impairment.
